Monastrell, Garnacha, Trepat



The Bocchoris Brut Nature Rosé is a remarkably expressive example of the red grapes that grow in Cava country, giving a perfect dark pink color to lay beneath the topper of soft and creamy

bubbles. The blend of Monastrell, Garnacha, and Trepat, leans towards an older style of Cava, showcasing more layers of complex fruit from these 20 30-year-old vines. After a traditional method of sparkling production (Method Champenoise), this wine aged on the lees for 12 months before disgorgement, and did not see a dosage, so it is a true, bone-dry Brut Nature. The nose is very expressive, with notes of currants, raspberries, rose pedals, and bread, and leads to a luscious mouth feel with dark berry fruit, flower tones, a bit of spicy earth, and a refreshing acidity that makes the wine go down very easy. A perfect bubbly to enjoy as an aperitif on a patio, with some firm cheeses and an assortment of salumi's and meats.

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
