

Casale della Ioria 'Campo Novo

(Cesanese del Piglio DOCG)

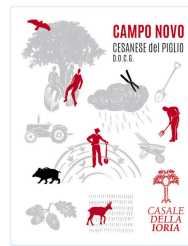
The Campo Novo is a vibrant yet remarkably complex version of the famous Cesanese of Lazio. The estate's younger vines (15 years) are harvested and spend about 15 days on the skins in steel fermenting with its own natural pied de cuve and receive punch downs daily, aged for one year, and bottled. The resulting wine is built to express the youthful side of the grape and has a wildly exuberant nose of tiny garden strawberries, wild blackberries, violets, fresh tar, and fresh berry cobbler. In the mouth, brambly fruit hits up front (blackberry, sour cherry, tiny blueberries, juicy plums) but goes straight into loads of amaro spices (juniper, thyme, mountain pine) to compliment the grippy tannins while staying very fresh on its feet.

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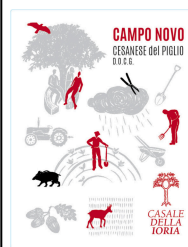
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
