The 'Sem Abrigo' Reserva means 'homeless,' as back in 2011, this wine came to be because there were a few vats of Reserva that had such a clearly unique and fantastic character to them that they could not be destined to mix with the others. Since it obviously needed to be its own wine, but had no particular name, these vats were considered 'homeless,' and all the way through to the wine being finally bottled, the name stuck. Fermented naturally in lagars, and aged in large cement vats, this wine is absolutely alive and delicious. A beautiful cornucopia of fruits, earthy backbone, and a purity given from its clean and characteristic Darei acidity, this red is built to enjoy now and for years to come.
