Olivier Cazenave 'Echappée Bel' Rosé

(Bordeaux)
100% Merlot



The Echappée Bel Rosé is a truly unique rosé, arguably the only one of its kind. Olivier sources Merlot from a trusted farmer who has a plot of Grand Cru vines in St. Emilion specifically for this rosé. The grapes are hand-harvested before the sugars become too high and brought to the cellar for a natural start to fermentation in stainless steel. After only one day, the grapes are pressed, giving the wine a gorgeous kiss of color, and then moved into 6-year-old Allier 600-liter barrels to continue fermenting. The aromatics are very pretty, full of soft berries, red plums, a hint of wood, and cherry cordial. Small strawberries explode in the mouth, and the balanced acidity adds to the texture of the wine with a long and delicious finish.



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
