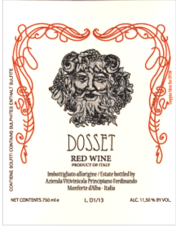


Principiano Ferdinando 'Dosset'

(Piedmont Red Wine)

Dolcetto



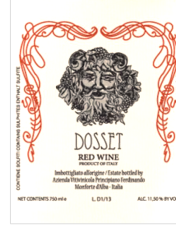
The Dosset takes its name from the old local dialect of the grape that rests in the bottle: Dolcetto. The fruit comes from the heart of the Monforte d'Alba zone, in the St. Anna and San Martino vineyards, and is brought into the cellar and treated so delicately in order to retain the pure freshness of the juice. It is made without the use of any sulfites, and meant for easy and everyday consumption, however the quality and style is unlike any 'typical' table wine. Low in alcohol, and remarkably fragrant on the nose, the Dosset showcases a light and dainty style of the grape while still being complex with nuanced fruit, ample acidity, and supple grape tannins.
