
Chateau Terre Forte Rouge!

(Côtes-du-Rhône AOC)

60% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 20% Mourvèdre



The Terre Forte Rouge! is an explosion of energy that has founds its way into a bottling of Southern Rhone red wine. A hand-harvest of mostly Grenache (along with some Syrah and Mourvèdre) coming from limestone rich clay soils and galette stones and placed into large concrete vats for a natural fermentation. After many months, the wine sees a tiny amount of SO2 before bottling, and sent off to market for a bright and expressive version of Cotes du Rhone. Brambly, yet juicy berry fruit, comes across immediately on the nose, with scents of peppercom, lemon-thyme, and iron. In the mouth, there is a grip of tannin that is quickly balanced by a flush of ripe red fruit, bright acidity, and a lightly spiced savory finish.



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
